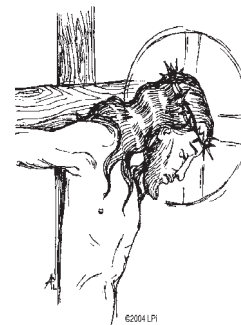

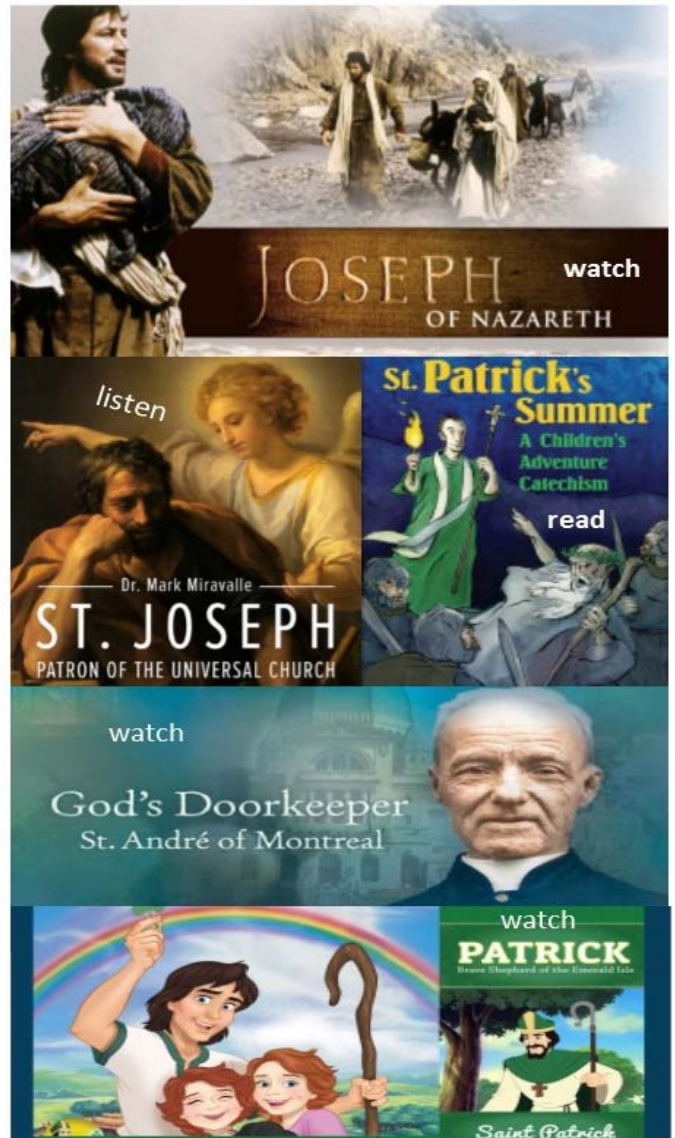

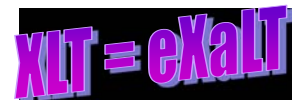

- **Cost is \$95 per FAMILY for the year**—includes monthly meals and all materials
- **1st Tuesday of the month**—7-8:30pm—adults are taught on the Third Pillar of the Catechism—Life with Christ, the Moral Life
 - Adults have the choice of attending this teaching in person in the HFA school Cafeteria—**OR**—view the teaching via our Live Stream on our Facebook Page—FFC at Ste Marie
- **Weeks 2 & 3 each month**—adults with children in Kindergarten to Grade 8 work on 2 lessons at home. Materials provided by Sophia Institute—A Family of Faith
- **3rd Saturday of the month**—the entire family attends 4pm Mass, shares a meal and participates in family activities until 7pm in Montminy Hall.
- **Accountability component** (changes each year according to the theme)

ALL NEW SACRAMENTAL PREP INFO!

Bishop Libasci has changed the age of Confirmation from high school to 3rd grade! Beginning Sept. 2018, students in 2nd grade will prepare for First Reconciliation only.

First Communion and Confirmation will take place at the same liturgy in the Spring of 3rd grade.

There is an implementation process in place for Ste. Marie to prepare all other students in grades 4 and up to receive Confirmation. *However, this process is too detailed for a bulletin ad. THEREFORE,* There will be an information session after the 9:30 & 11:30am Masses on Sunday, May 6 in Montminy Hall.

Additional information sessions will be held Sun., Sept. 16 & 23 after 9:30 & 11:30 Masses.
